



BOYCE WORTHLEY YOUNG ACHIEVER AWARD

Prize: EPSM Conference registration, travel and accommodation (the following year).

This award honours one of the founding members of the ACPSEM, Boyce Worthley, who was a senior physicist with the Anti-Cancer Foundation in Adelaide, South Australia, and the first to be awarded Life Membership of the ACPSEM.

The Young Achiever award is given to a younger member of the College who has made a significant contribution to the profession of physical and engineering sciences in medicine, generally with several publications in refereed journals as a primary author.

Minimum Criteria

- A Financial Member (Associate or above) of the ACPSEM for at least 12 months
- The nominee must be within the first 15 years of their career in the field of Medical Physics and Biomedical Engineering, **or** have gained their professional certification in the last 10 years.
- The nominee has made a substantial contribution to the physical or engineering medical sciences, demonstrated by several publications as primary author in refereed journals

ACPSEM Judging Criteria

The following are the criteria for assessment of the nomination:

- The number of refereed publications, including those as first author
- Contribution to clinical practice
- Conference contributions and involvement
- Tertiary qualifications
- Teaching experience
- ACPSEM registration in one or more specialty

To Apply

All Fellows, Ordinary and Associate Members can nominate persons for this award.

The application is to include:

- Full name, title and academic qualifications
- Position and Place of work
- Thumbnail photograph, and nominee contact details (phone number and email address)
- Details of refereed publications, or other evidence of professional/clinical contributions;
- CV with covering letter addressing the eligibility and judging criteria
