

RICHARD BATES TRAVEL AWARD

Prize: Maximum value of \$5,000 AUD

This scholarship honours the 3rd President of the ACPSEM, Richard Bates, Professor of Electrical Engineering at the University of Canterbury, Christchurch. His expertise lay in the field of signal and image processing. Richard Bates supervised more than 50 Masters and PhD students, many of whom are ACPSEM members to this day.

The scholarship is awarded to assist a Medical Physicist, Radiopharmaceutical Scientist, or Engineer to undertake a period of study or research project overseas. The study or project must be perceived to be of broad benefit to the profession of physical and engineering sciences in medicine.

The intent of this award is to advance research in medical physics, radiopharmaceutical science or biomedical engineering.

Minimum Criteria

- A Financial Member (Associate or above) of the ACPSEM for at least 12 months

ACPSEM Judging Criteria

The following are the criteria for assessment of the nomination:

- The applicant's proposed period of study or research must extend beyond a brief site visit or simply attending a conference
- The project enhances research in medical physics, radiopharmaceutical sciences or biomedical engineering **and/or** is of broad benefit to the ACPSEM or profession
- The submitted plan is detailed and realistic
- Capability of the applicant to deliver the proposed project

To Apply

Your application is to include:

- Full name, title and academic qualifications
- Position and Place of work
- Thumbnail photograph, and nominee contact details (phone number and email address)
- Details of Study or Research Proposal; together with
- Evidence, such as publications record, to demonstrate the benefit of your project or study to the ACPSEM and/or broader medical sciences profession.
