Minimum Criteria

- The Applicant will have been awarded their PhD from an Australian or New Zealand University between 1 July 2024 to 30 June 2026.

ACPSEM Judging Criteria

The following are the criteria for assessment of the nominated thesis:

- Clinical relevance
- Scientific merit and novelty
- Publication capacity arising from the work
- Content that aligns with objectives of ACPSEM and the professional roles of ACPSEMmembers

To Apply

The ACPSEM does not accept self-nominations for this award. Candidates must be nominated by a Colleague or Supervisor.

The nominator must submit:

- The nominee's full name and email address.
- A thumbnail photo of the nominee
- A brief letter of justification (no more than 1 page)
- An abstract of the nominee's thesis
- A brief CV of the nominee, including a list of current publications
- A copy of the nominee's PhD certificate, including a mark where applicable
