# Lyn D. Oliver Excellence in Clinical Translation AWARD

## **Background**

The Award is named in honour of A/Prof Lyn Oliver AM. Lyn was part of the steering committee that created the College and has held offices with the College beginning in 1978 (Honorary Secretary) and concluding in 2024, finishing his service as a Board member of the Foundation. All of his notable contributions are too long to list here. Still, honourable mentions include his involvement in helping develop the accreditation system for Medical Physicists through the ACPSEM in 1985 and College President in 2004 -5 around the time of the Baume Inquiry. This was one of the most active times for the College inside a community push through the Baume Report for significant changes to Health Care and Cancer Care awareness, resulting in much needed Federal funds to the College.
